Clues:

1. Clue 1:- The science of poisons.
2. Clue 2:- A chemical that changes color showing the presence of some unknown material.
3. Clue 3:- The amount of a substance that will dissolve in a given amount of another substance which makes it seem to disappear.
4. Clue 4:- A natural formation of a chemical. This could be a small cube like sugar or salt.
5. Clue 5:- A poisonous substance that is a specific product of the metabolic activities of a living organism.
6. Clue 6:- Burning fibers to see what types of gasses are produced. This helps scientists determine what the content of a fiber is.
7. Clue 7:- Fibers created from plants or animal products. Examples include Linen, Silk, Cotton and Wool.
8. Clue 8:- A fabric woven with fibers from the flax plant.
9. Clue 9:- A fabric made from the cocoon, larval home, of a silk worm.
10. Clue 10:- A fabric made from the cotton plant.
11. Clue 11:- A fabric made from the soft, curly hair of a sheep. It is oily and tangled.
12. Clue 12:- Fibers made from materials other than plant or animal products, such as a combination of chemicals. Examples include Nylon, Polyester, Satin.
13. Clue 13:- A man-made fiber with long thin fibers, strands.
14. Clue 14:- A man-made fiber similar to satin but stronger.
15. Clue 15:- A man-made fiber similar to nylon with long thin fibers.
