Clues:

1. Clue 1:- The part of the hair that is above the skin.
2. Clue 2:- The outer layer of a hair.
3. Clue 3:- The inner or deep layer of hair.
4. Clue 4:- A tube shaped sheath that nourishes and surrounds the hair under the first two layers of the skin.
5. Clue 5:- Evidence that can positively convict a suspect of a crime.
6. Clue 6:- Hair transferred directly from the part of the body where it is growing.
7. Clue 7:- Hair that falls off and is transferred from clothing or objects.
8. Clue 8:- A microscope used by forensic scientists in order to have side by side comparisons of a crime scene sample and the known sample, the one collected from the suspect.
9. Clue 9:- The science of analyzing pollen and spores to help solve criminal cases.
10. Clue 10:- The powdery material produced by the anther.
11. Clue 11:- A specific mix of microscopic pollen grains and spores from plants in a particular geographic region.
12. Clue 12:- The handling, examination and evaluation of dental evidence.
13. Clue 13:- Front, flat-edged teeth on the top and bottom of your jaw.
14. Clue 14:- The teeth located on either sides of the incisors that look like “fangs” on both the top and bottom of your jaw.
15. Clue 15:- Teeth located behind the canines. They are wide and flat for grinding food and are located on the top and bottom of your jaw.
16. Clue 16:- Teeth located behind the premolars. They are wide and flat for grinding food. They are located on top and bottom of your jaw.
